§8 Liability for Content

As a service provider, we are responsible for our own content on our websites or in our apps according to the general laws in accordance with § 7 Abs.1 TMG. According to §§ 8 to 10 TMG, however, we as a service provider are not obligated to monitor transmitted or stored third-party information or to investigate circumstances that indicate an illegal activity.



Obligations to remove or block the use of information in accordance with general laws remain unaffected. However, liability in this regard is only possible from the moment of knowledge of a specific infringement. Upon notification of appropriate violations, we will remove this content immediately.

§9 Liability for Links

Data Protection Policy

§11 Data Protection

As the operator of our websites or apps (collectively "*Services*"), we take the protection of your personal information very seriously. We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the legal data protection regulations and this privacy policy.

Our services can be utilized as far as possible without providing personal data. If personal data (see below) is collected on our websites or in the Apps, this is always done on a voluntary basis. These data will not be disclosed to third parties without your explicit consent.

Which personal information is collected depends on the nature of the service and your specific use of that service. Typical data are for:

- Personalized services: Full name, place or country of residence, email address, mobile phone number; possibly also payment data, such as credit card or account data.
- Analytical services: Records of your usage behavior, in particular start and end of use, activities performed, results (e.g., high scores).
- Technical services: In particular identification (IMEI / UDID / MAC), type and operating system version of the device used; browser type and version, network service, geographic location, errors encountered or problems.
- Medical services: E.g. anamnesis, diagnosis, images (e.g. x-ray), recordings of body-functions (e.g. ECG), treating physicians, treatment or treatment plans and their adherence to, trend analysis of illness or therapy progress.

We use the above personal data

- for the purposes for which you have specifically entered this information, including, but not limited to, processing or responding to your requests to provide you with the specific results, analyses or diagnoses you may require from your use of our services; to fulfill our contract of use with you;
- to send you information about your relationship with us or transactions with us (such as update notifications, security alerts, billing);
- to operate our services reliably and securely, as well as to continually improve your user experience; this may include offers for additional services;
- to derive aggregated and anonymized non-personal data (for example, for usage statistics);



- for our internal business purposes, such as data, usage and trend analysis to improve our products; A/B analyzes of product innovations, etc.;
- for the continuous improvement of our applications (in particular by re-training our Artificial Intelligence (AI) software with these data) or for developing new products by training an AI with these data; in any case, all data will be completely anonymized for this purpose;
- to meet regulatory requirements and to enable audits.

In no case will we sell your personal data to external service providers or interested parties!

Please note that data transmission over the Internet (for example, when communicating by e-mail) may have security vulnerabilities. A perfect protection of your data from access by third parties is not possible.

§12 Cookies

CellmatiQ's website does not currently use cookies. If this changes, the following applies:

Cookies do not harm your computer and do not contain viruses. Cookies are used to make our offer more user-friendly, effective and secure. Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer and stored by your browser.

Most of the cookies we use are so-called "session cookies". They are automatically deleted after your visit. Other cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. These cookies allow us to recognize your browser upon your next visit.

You can set your browser so that you are informed about the setting of cookies and allow cookies only in individual cases, exclude the acceptance of cookies for certain cases or in general, and to enable the automatic deletion of cookies when closing the browser. Disabling cookies may limit the functionality of this website.

§13 Server-Log-Files

The website provider automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. These are:

- Browser type and browser version
- Operating system used
- Referrer URL
- Host name of the accessing computer



- Time of the server request

These data cannot be associated with specific persons. A combination of these data with other data sources is not undertaken. We reserve the right to check this data retrospectively, if we become aware of specific indications for illegal use.

§14 Contact Form

If you send us inquiries via the contact form, your details (including the contact information) from the inquiry form will be stored in order to process the request and in case of follow-up questions. We will not share this information without your consent.

§15 Newsletter Data

In case we offer a newsletter on the website and you wish to receive this newsletter, we need an e-mail address from you, as well as information that allows us to verify that you are the owner of the given e-mail address and agree to the receipt of the newsletter. Further data is not collected. We use this data only for the delivery of the requested information and do not pass it on to third parties.

If we offer a newsletter on the website, you can revoke the given consent to the storage of the data, the e-mail address, and their use for sending the newsletter at any time, for example via a "unsubscribe" link in the newsletter.

§16 LinkedIn

Our website uses features from the LinkedIn network, provided by LinkedIn Corporation (2029 Stierlin Court, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA, <https://www.linkedin.com>). Each time you visit one of our pages that includes LinkedIn features, it will connect to LinkedIn servers. LinkedIn is informed that you have visited our website with your IP address. If you e.g. click on LinkedIn's "Recommend Button" and are logged into LinkedIn's LinkedIn account, LinkedIn will be able to associate your visit to our website with you and your user account. We point out that we as the provider of the pages have no knowledge of the content of the transmitted data, as well as their use by LinkedIn.

We use Mixpanel to collect data from your usage (i.e., your activities in the app) for analytic purposes and to evaluate it for product improvements. Potentially, we may also use Mixpanel as a communications medium for user communication (via email or as notifications within the app). As part of the service agreement, Mixpanel will also collect your publicly available contact and social information (e.g., age, gender, photos, occupation, title, ...), if any.
